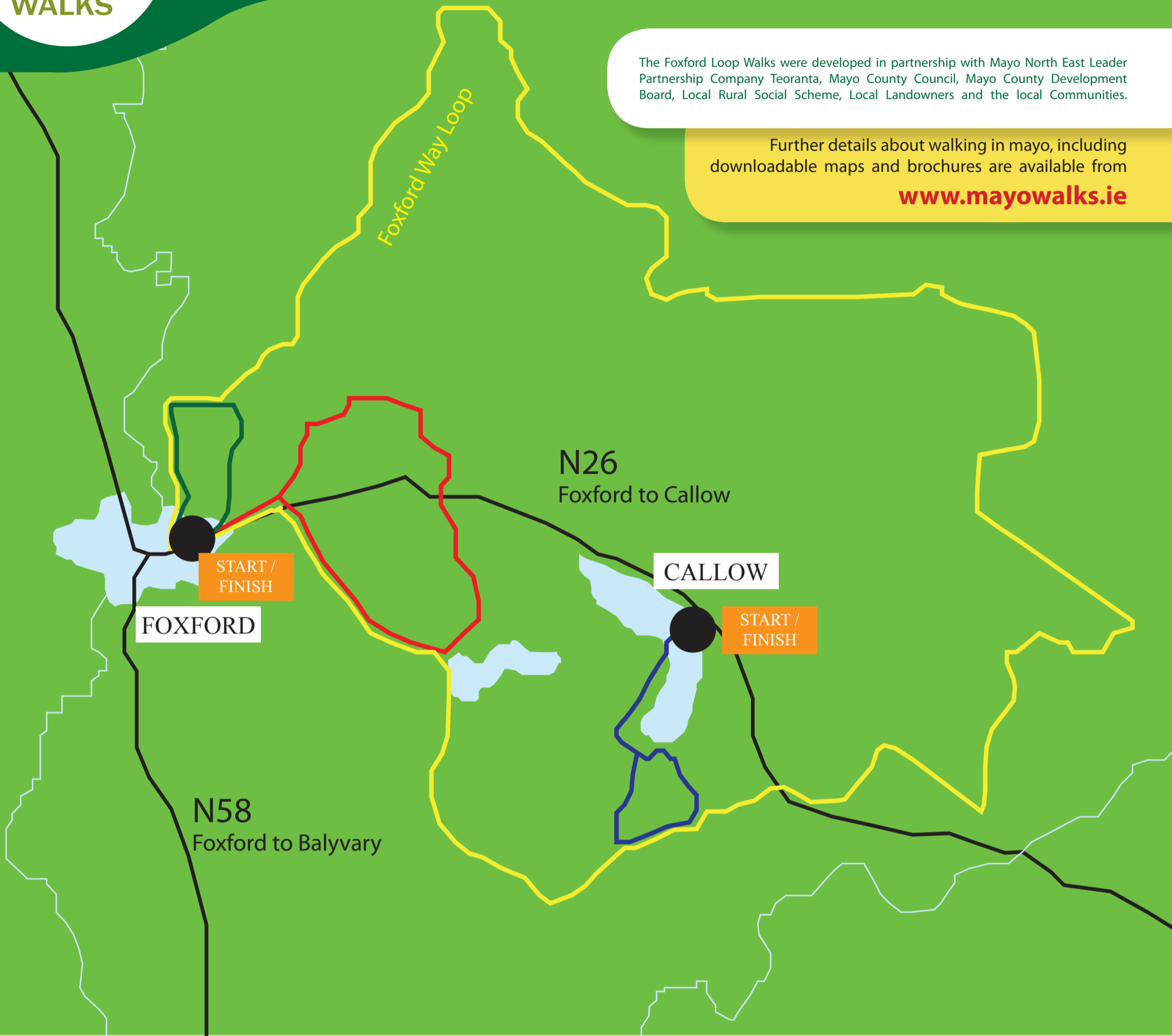




Foxford Loop Walks

Name: Green Loop
Trailhead: Car park, located beside Children's Playground
Distance: 4km
Estimated Time: 1 hour
Trail Waymarking: Waymarked using Green Directional Arrows
Terrain: Country Lanes
Level of Difficulty: Easy
Minimum Gear: Walking Shoes, Raingear, Snack, Fluid & Mobile Phone.

Name: Shanwar / Belgarrow Loop
Trailhead: Car park, located beside Children's Playground
Distance: 8km
Estimated Time: 1 hr 30mins – 2hrs
Trail Waymarking: Waymarked using Red Directional Arrows
Terrain: Country Lanes
Level of Difficulty: Moderate - Hard
Minimum Gear: Walking Shoes, Raingear, Snack, Fluid & Mobile Phone.

Name: Foxford Way Loop
Trailhead: Car park, located beside Children's Playground
Distance: 33 km
Estimated Time: 8hr – 9hr
Trail Waymarking: Waymarked using the Yellow Walking Man & Directional Arrows
Terrain: Country Lanes, Grassy Paths, Mountain track
Level of Difficulty: Hard
Minimum Gear: Walking Shoes, Raingear, Snack, Fluid & Mobile Phone.

Name: Callow Loop Walk
Directions: Located just off the N26 Foxford – Swinford Road
Trailhead: Pier at Callow Lake, Parking for up to 5 Cars
Distance: 6.5km
Estimated Time: 2 hours
Trail Waymarking: Waymarked using Blue Directional Arrows
Terrain: Country Lanes
Level of Difficulty: Easy
Minimum Gear: Walking Shoes, Raingear, Snack, Fluid & Mobile Phone.
